REGULATIONS

- 1) The seventh edition of the **Rencontres Internationales Sciences et Cinémas (RISC)** [International Science & Film Festival] will take place in Marseilles, from 10th – 19th October 2013.
- 2) The **Rencontres Internationales Sciences et Cinémas** is organised by the **Polly Maggoo association**, whose aim is to show contemporary films throughout the year, with a wide range of artistic approaches, production budgets and subjects.
- 3) **All genres of film** (documentary, experimental film, fiction, art video, animation, etc.) are eligible if their subject is directly related to scientific topics (including fundamental sciences, life sciences, the environment, medicine, social and human sciences, etc.).
- 4) There are no criteria as regards length or format (video or film). Foreign language films must be made available with **the original language soundtrack** and **French Subtitles**.
- 5) Preference will be given to the most original approaches and to recently-produced films (however, there is no exclusive criterion as regards the date of production).
- 6) Parallel to the international programme this year's festival will include a **competition for the best Euro-Mediterranean films**. Three prizes will be awarded: the Public Viewers' Prize, the Young Viewers' Prize and the Jury's Prize (the jury will be composed of scientists, cinema studies lecturers and film industry professionals).
- 7) Film registration forms must be fully completed, signed, and sent to the Polly Maggoo Association together with **two DVD copies (or video files)** of the film. A registration form must be completed **for each film submitted**, whatever its length.
- 8) For selected films, shipping and insurance costs must be paid by the sender, as well as all other related costs.
- 9) The Festival will pay the return cost of the copies.
- 10) The owners of the films' rights authorise **free public showing** of the films in all events organised as part of the Festival.

11) The holders of the films' rights agree to **provide extracts of the films free of charge** (with a running time of up to 3 minutes) for promotional purposes.

12) The Festival will pay insurance costs exclusively during the period between reception and return of the films. If they are lost or damaged during this period, the Festival shall be only liable for the **cost of replacing** the copy.

13) The Polly Maggoo association **reserves the right to keep** in the video library a DVD copy of the **films** which, where applicable, may be proposed as part of other events (such as *Fête de la Science* and "*Cinésciences*" activities throughout the year), subject to the agreement of the holders of the rights to the said films.

14) Submission of entry to the festival is **free of charge**, but it implies unreserved acceptance of the terms and conditions of these regulations. If there is any dispute concerning the terms and conditions, only the text in French shall be legally valid.
